### Options 2024 What's it all about .....

In Years 7, 8 and 9 pupils follow a broad and balanced curriculum designed to give basic knowledge and skills

In Key Stage 4 pupils will concentrate on a smaller range of subjects and study each one in much greater depth



## Options 2024

What pupils choose to study in Key Stage 4 (Years 10 & 11) is massively important and will have an influence on the rest of their life.

It is really important that they think very carefully about their choices.

Unless they have a very specific career in mind there are no subjects which they have to choose in order to get into college/university/training.



## **Options 2024**

When they leave Wordsley School in the Summer of 2026, they have to continue in education either full time or as part of an Apprenticeship or Technical Qualifications.

Generally Colleges require them to have 5 GCSEs, including English and Maths, at Grade 4/5 or above to gain access to their Level 3 courses.


