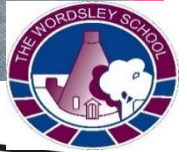
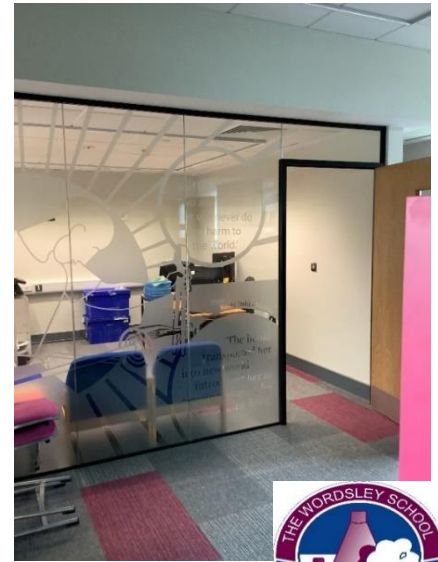


# Careers Newsletter
