Dear Parents/Carers,

Over the last few weeks the pastoral team and I have been out visiting Year 6 pupils making all of the arrangements necessary for a seamless transition for your child to join us in September.

It's been an absolute delight meeting everyone and being able to answer their questions about what Wordsley life is like. If your child has not been visited yet then rest assure we still have a few more schools to visit over the next couple of weeks.

Please find below a reminder of key dates, times and information.

<u>Year 6 Induction Day – Tuesday 1st July and Wednesday 2nd July 2025 (8:40am - 3:00pm).</u>

On Induction Day, your child needs to bring their golden ticket with them which was handed out during their primary visit, if pupils have lost their golden ticket then please do not worry.

Pupils will receive a welcome goody bag filled with lots of amazing gifts. Your child will need to wear their primary school uniform as normal. They should bring writing equipment, a bottle of water and, if they wish, a snack for morning break. At lunchtime, a hot school meal (including a vegetarian option) will be provided free of charge on both days. If your child has any specific dietary requirements, we would advise them to bring a packed lunch. Year 6 Parents' and Carers' Coffee Morning - Tuesday 1st July (8.45am-9.15am).

We would also like to invite parents and carers to a coffee morning after dropping off your child on Induction day. (This is optional – we appreciate many parents have work commitments.) During this time, you will have the opportunity to meet key staff, ask any questions, as well as receiving help filling in key forms. We will also have information on school uniform, Parent Pay and Class Charts to help assist you in preparation for when your child starts secondary school.

Year 6 Induction Evening for Parents - Wednesday 2nd July (6-7pm)

This event is essential for parents/carers of all pupils joining us in September 2025. During this evening Mr Weatherhogg and I will introduce ourselves as well as giving a brief speech. After this you will be able to meet your child's form tutor and will have the opportunity to ask any questions. It would be great if your child could attend as well as they may not have met

Summer School - Tuesday 22nd July and Wednesday 23rd July (9.30am-1.30pm).

As you are aware this year we will be offering a summer school, where your child can get to know the school, staff and the location of each subject. We will be running different activities throughout the day and exploring a range of subjects. This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to make new friends. There is still time to sign your child up to summer school, if you haven't done so already. During summer school your child must bring a drink and a packed lunch for both days. Pupils will also need to wear suitable clothing as there will be a variety of lessons taking place. If your child takes any medication please make sure that they have it with them or it has been handed into a member of staff on the day.
