Dear parents and carers of Year 8 students,

I would like to start with a big thank you to you all. It has been a great privilege to take on this cohort of students. The respect they show and their attitude to their learning is a great indication of the love and support they receive from yourselves. They are a credit to you.

Our tutor team work tirelessly to support your child and provide the pastoral care that they need. I am very proud of our team. They are constantly coming up with new ideas and interventions to make your child's experience a more positive one.
