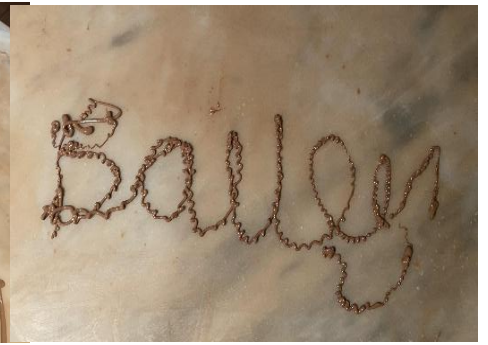
National Apprenticeship & Education Event at Millennium Point
