Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to make you aware of a social media trend currently circulating on platforms such as TikTok and Snapchat referred to as "School Wars". These posts encourage groups of pupils from different schools to organise and attend fights, sometimes dividing participants into "red" and "blue" sides and suggesting meeting points outside of school.

This is not an issue specific to our school. Reports of this trend have been shared nationally and across a number of regions. The police are aware of the situation and are monitoring it closely.

We want to reassure you that we do not tolerate any behaviour of this nature. The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is always our highest priority. Staff will remain vigilant and will continue to listen carefully for any conversations or information related to this trend so that concerns can be addressed promptly.

We are also working closely with the police and will continue to support any pupils who may feel worried or unsettled by what they may have seen online. At the same time, we will take any necessary steps to ensure that the school community remains safe.

We would encourage parents and carers to speak with their children about responsible use of social media and to remind them of the importance of staying safe and making positive choices.
