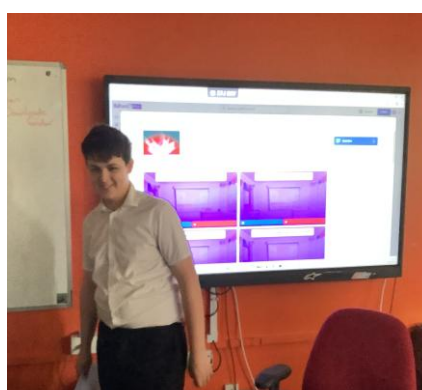

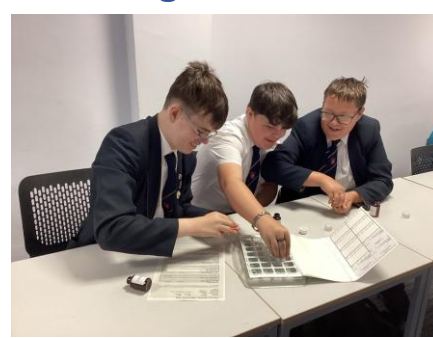
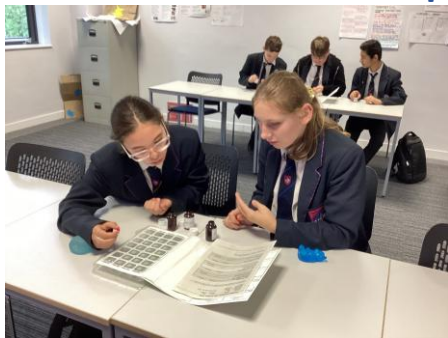
WORK EXPERIENCE 29TH JUNE – 3RD JULY 2026

NHS Workshop and Careers Fair at Halesowen College

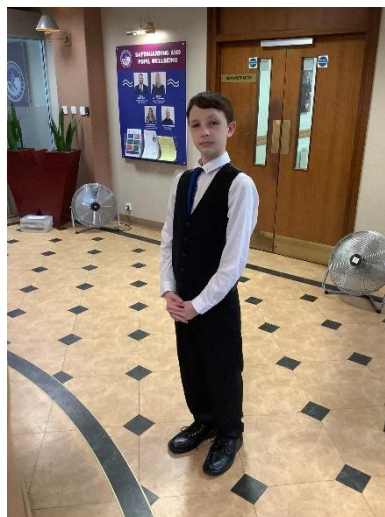
