Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of the first week, I'd like to take this opportunity to praise your children for the way they have approached coming back to school. They arrived looking smart and seemed to be genuinely pleased to be here. There has been a lovely atmosphere around the school and everyone has settled back in well.

### Site Improvements

There has been a great deal of work done to the school site over the holiday, all with the aim of improving facilities and making them safer for pupils and staff. This has included:

- Full refurbishment of the girls' toilet facilities and a new set of KS3 toilets for boys. This has often been raised on pupil and parent surveys. These facilities are modern, clean and fit for purpose.
- Full refurbishment of the Music rooms.
- Extension of the main playground down to the field, removing trees and roots identified as being potentially unsafe.
- New windows, paths, steps and fencing to improve safety.
- Modernisation and redecoration of many areas of the school.
- Newly modelled Reception area, designed to add an extra layer of security for staff and pupils.

I'd like to thank Stour Vale Academy Trust for their help and support with these projects, as well as a huge shout out to our site staff who have worked incredibly hard all summer. Hopefully the pupils noticed the difference.
